Truro, NS – Truro Town Council does not support the decision made by Canada Post last month to eliminate door to door delivery in urban centres.

Council has reviewed the information on the decision by Canada Post and Council members have also attended a recent “town hall” style meeting, during which residents voiced their concerns.

“Losing the downtown post office was a blow to the town, and to now lose door to door delivery...it’s a real concern, especially for those with mobility issues” says Mayor Bill Mills.
