

# Town of Truro – Bylaws

**Subject:** A Bylaw Respecting Firearms  
**Bylaw Number:** B130-00

## Title

1. This Bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the “Firearms Bylaw”.

## Interpretation

2. In this Bylaw:

“Firearm” means any barreled weapon from which any shot, bullet, or other projectile can be discharged and that is capable of causing serious bodily injury or death to a person, but does not include an air or compressed gas gun or pistol.

## Discharge of Firearm

3. No person shall discharge a firearm in the Town of Truro.

## Approved Shooting Range

4. This Bylaw does not apply to the discharge of firearms at a shooting range approved pursuant to the *Firearms Act* (Canada) and regulations under the Act.

## Penalties, Enforcement

5. Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of this Bylaw commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a penalty of not less than \$500 and not more than \$10,000 or, in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period of not less than 30 days.

## Revocation/Amendment

6. The Public Safety – Firearms and Fireworks Bylaw is revoked.
