End of the boil water advisory

Truro – After two consecutive sets of drinking water samples have been found free of bacteria, the Town of Truro is pleased to announce that the Boil Water Advisory has been removed (effective immediately).

The Boil Water Advisory had been issued on Thursday Dec 22nd in the morning, after 1 of our regular 16 sample locations was positive for e-coli from this week's sampling program. It was the appropriate course of action, in case this possible contamination had not been isolated to this sample location.

The Truro Water Utility, Nova Scotia Environment, and the Medical Officer of Health worked as quick as possible and in close consultation to resolve this issue. The Truro Water Utility appreciates all the public's patience and understanding during the past two days.
