Don't Miss Truro's Eighth Annual Easter Egg Hunt

Truro – Attention Easter egg hunters. Free tickets are available now for the eighth annual Truro Easter Egg Hunt to be held Saturday, April 8 at 11 a.m. in Victoria Park.

Hundreds of excited children converge on the park each year to participate in this popular event, which is hosted by Truro Parks, Recreation and Culture. This is also an opportunity to meet the Downtown Truro Partnership Easter Bunny.

Free tickets are available at three Truro locations, the Douglas Street Recreation Centre, the Truro Library and the Marigold Cultural Centre.

Here's how the event works. Thousands of colourful plastic eggs will be placed in a designated hunting ground in Victoria Park. Beginning at 11 a.m., children ages 10 and under will be invited to hunt for five eggs each that match the colour of their tickets. They will exchange their five eggs for one special treat bag.

Please note, there will be one treat bag per child and parental supervision is required.

If weather or ground conditions make it impossible to hold the hunt, children are welcome to redeem their tickets for treat bags at Douglas Street Recreation Centre during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. from Monday, April 10 to Thursday, April 13.
