

## **Accessibility Maintenance Plans**

The Town of Truro is committed to maintaining accessible public spaces and infrastructure.

In accordance with the Nova Scotia Built Environment Accessibility Standard Regulations, the Town has developed the following plans to support the maintenance of accessible municipal infrastructure.

### **Snow and Ice Control - Pedestrian Facilities**

The Town of Truro manages snow and ice removal on pedestrian facilities as part of municipal winter maintenance operations.

Pedestrian facilities may include sidewalks, curb ramps, crosswalks, and pedestrian pathways owned or maintained by the Town.

Winter maintenance activities are carried out by the Public Works Department to help maintain safe pedestrian travel during winter weather conditions.



## **Maintenance of Accessible Parking Areas**

The Town of Truro maintains municipal parking areas to ensure accessibility features remain available and usable.

Regular maintenance includes:

- Maintaining accessibility features within parking areas
- Repainting accessibility symbols and parking space lines as required
- Maintaining parking area surfaces, including pedestrian pathways
- Maintaining accessibility signage within parking areas

These activities are carried out as part of the Town's regular Public Works maintenance operations.



## **Accessible Entrances**

The Town of Truro works to ensure that barrier-free entrances at Town-owned buildings remain free of physical obstruction.

Barrier-free entrances are designed to allow access for people using mobility devices and others requiring accessible entry.

Staff work to ensure entrances remain accessible during normal operations and maintenance activities.
