1. **APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

On motion of Councillors J. Flemming and B. Thomas, the Agenda was approved as circulated. Motion carried.

2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

On motion of Councillors J. Barnard and A. Graham, the Minutes for February 25th, 2021, were approved as circulated. Motion carried.

3. **DOWNTOWN TRURO PARTNERSHIP**

Executive Director Rochelle Roberts presented the Downtown Truro Partnership's proposed 2021-2022 budget.

4. **FLOOD RISK STUDY & RECOMMENDATIONS**

Director of Public Works A. MacKinnon provided Council with a flood presentation which included CBCL's 2016 Flood Study and associated recommendations as well as noting projects that the Town has already undertaken assisting with flood mitigation.

5. **UPDATE: NOVA SCOTIA REMEMBERS EVENT**

CAO M. Dolter provided an update on the Nova Scotia Remembers event scheduled for April 18th, 2021 to honour the victims of the 2020 NS massacre. A full marathon will start in Portapique and end in Victoria Park where there will be a commemorative walk set up. Director of Public Works A. MacKinnon, Director of Parks, Recreation & Culture A. Simms, and Police Chief D. MacNeil have been working with event organizers. Next week a meeting is scheduled with organizers to discuss media. Council will be advised once plans are finalized.

6. **VICTORIA PARK POOL SPONSORSHIP/DONATION CATALOGUE**

Director of Parks, Recreation & Culture A. Simms provided an overview on the Victoria Park Pool sponsorship and donation catalogue. Individuals can also donate via Canada Helps and by coming into Town Hall. It was noted to be cognizant of diversity regarding the use of photos for the catalogue.
