1. **APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

It was suggested that Council's donation be announced, and a challenge issued to the public to encourage more donations.

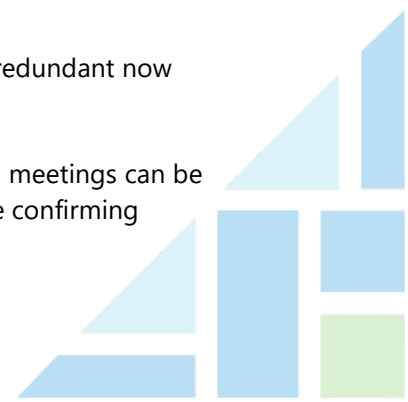
5. **COUNCIL OPEN HOUSE**
