1. **APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

On motion of Councillors J. Flemming and A. Graham, the agenda was approved as circulated. Motion carried.

2. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

CAO M. Dolter advised Council of a request to develop an Advertising Bylaw that requires adult stores to have covered windows and no advertising where it is visible to minors. It was of staff's opinion that a bylaw is not warranted at this time. A bylaw of this nature would essentially be targeting one business. Council concurred with staff's opinion and agreed to not proceed with this request.
