Central Nova Scotia Tourism Development Society – Nick Sharpe

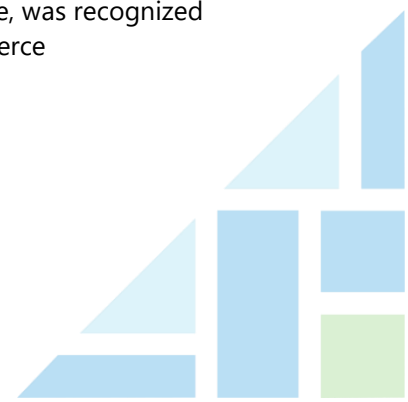
