1. **Approval of the Agenda**

The agenda of the April 16, 2026, Committee of the Whole meeting was approved as circulated.

2. **Approval of Minutes**

3. **Downtown Truro Partnership – Saribel DesLaurier**

Saribel DesLaurier of the Downtown Truro Partnership provided an update on the organization's activities, including upcoming events, downtown beautification efforts, and its current budget.

Mayor C. Hinton asked whether the Downtown Truro Partnership would participate in the upcoming Rock the Hub event, to which DesLaurier confirmed their involvement in promotional efforts.

Councillor W. Talbot requested clarification regarding the budget deficit. DesLaurier responded that she is working to secure grants to address the shortfall.

Councillor I. McGrath inquired about plans to close Inglis Street to vehicle traffic over the summer months. DesLaurier explained that the street will be closed for one weekend per month in June and July, as well as in either August or September.
